

Harry the Hedgehog

This activity takes a little patience but you won't be able to resist stroking your Hedge Hogs' soft feathery spines!

You will need

Plastic pot

Approx 10cm diameter at top
eg Anathoth Farm 455g jam pot or a honey pot

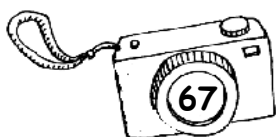
Egg Carton (not tray)

Milk and Fizzy bottle lids

Glossy magazine paper or brown paper

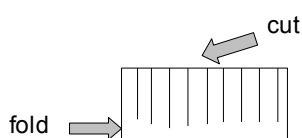
Tools

Hot glue
Scissors



1 make spines

Take a magazine page and fold paper over and over on itself to form a strip approx 5cm high (5cm will be the length of your spines). Trim off the top of one long side. Now cut strips as shown, leaving a little at the bottom. *We will call each layer a spine strip.*



once cut and opened out each spine strip should look a little like this. →



2 attach spines

Lay pot on its side, lay each spine strip, one at a time, flat onto pot and tape on. Feather out spines a little as you go. Work your way from half way down one side over top to half way down other side.



3 face

Cut out two cups from an egg carton leaving the long point divider between them attached. (see photo in photo section)

Draw eyeballs onto two fizzy bottle lids and glue into to milk bottle lids. Then glue into the egg cups to complete the face.



Stuff pottle with a little paper.
Now glue face into opening of pottle.

4 feet

Glue two milk bottle lids together next to each other to make front feet. Repeat to make back feet. Now glue each set of feet to bottle front and back of pot.
